Message from the Principal

Dear Parents,

We are into the final week of the 2024 school year. Today - Monday 2nd December - our students were offsite at our annual Athletics Carnival. Students from **Prep to Grade 5** will have their **Presentation Night on Wednesday 4th December** from 6.30pm to 9pm. That is the **last day of school for those in Prep to Grade 5**. Students from **Grade 6 to Year 12** will have their **Presentation Night on Friday December 6th** from 6.30pm to 9pm. Please be punctual and park as directed. Let us make sure that there is minimal movement and noise during the presentation. Students should be in **full school uniform** (including hair) and for the rest who are attending the dress code will be modest, semi-formal.

Last week began with Grade 6 Graduation on Monday evening. Our graduates were well attired for the occasion and their speeches and items were of a very high quality. This was our biggest Grade 6 cohort. 117 students graduated and we had over 400 people at the graduation. Both our students and staff made the occasion very special. There was a real appreciation from the students for the efforts of their parents and teachers. It concluded with prayers of blessing over the students as they advance into secondary schooling as young adults. On Tuesday we had Orientation for 2025 Prep students and students for other grades. We have about 65 students for Prep 2025 as of now and this could increase to about 70 by next year. Entry into other year levels is limited by our 1000 student cap by Department of Transport. All those who attended the orientation were enthusiastic about Christian schooling. We also had books and stationery orders for 2025 picked up by parents. Thanks to Mrs Cicchiello and Mrs Melchi for handling the distribution.

On Wednesday students in Grade 3, 5, Year 7 and 9 had their NAPLAN parties for their hard work and success in the NAPLAN.

We also gave out the Certificates of Distinction for the Australian Mathematics Competition. In total we had **67 distinctions**. Those who received a High Distinction will be presented theirs at their respective Presentation Nights.

Mr Steel organised a table tennis competition on Wednesday with the help of other staff and the
